

# DIPTYQUE UNVEILS ITS TRIBUTE TO THE TRAVELLING SPIRIT WITH A COLLECTION OF DECORATIVE OBJECTS TO ENSURE THE PERFECT SUMMER



Diptyque's latest summer masterpiece is a close encounter between nature, that inexhaustible wellspring of inspiration and enlightenment, and our own living spaces as they endlessly evolve to the rhythm of this fairest of seasons.

In a collection dedicated to wanderlust, every element further stimulates the dialogue between the domestic interior and the great outdoors, opening wide a window to the world of dreams and the imagination. These limited edition decorative objects are a hedonistic echo of the Maison's perfumed summer rendezvous, inspired by its fundamental principles: the poetry of flowers, the aesthetic Mediterranean palette and travel in all its forms, be they real or dreamed.

The flower – vital to perfumers, essential in the herbarium of scents – becomes a precious object in this collection, to be taken everywhere and preserved as a memento. Freshly picked while strolling, then protected between the pages of a Flower Press – a practice much favoured by the founders of Diptyque, whose travel journals were strewn with dried flowers attesting to countless wanderings. A flower is portable: it can be carried by hand or attached to the handlebars of a bicycle. Or slipped into a Stem Vase created in collaboration with Coco Brun by combining a sheath made of leather offcuts with a stem vase in borosilicate glass: a distinctive, unusual accessory to accompany you on your next adventures.

Flowers may also be gathered into a bouquet and placed in the wax Medicis Vase, a signature Diptyque object displaying an artisanal prowess inspired by vases from antiquity. For this limited edition, the Medicis Vase is available in Mediterranean blue – one of this summer's key colours, also found both on the Matchbox bearing our emblematic oval motif and on the iconic Coasted Candle Holder.

The latter object was inspired by the jars that one of the Maison’s founders used to collect, and is hand-blown in a French glassblowers’ workshop. By candlelight, its seasonal hues fill the room with blue-tinted glimmerings. The small Candle Holder with its crystalline finish rounds off the coasted items in the collection, its iconic contours reinterpreted by Studio Jean-Marc Gady to create a glorious setting for any of the Maison’s miniature candles. Either singly or grouped together, the hand-blown glass dome protects the candle flame, adding extra sparkle to the summertime table.

Outdoors, the Diptyque flame loses none of its radiance: its gentle glow remains the ideal accompaniment for summer evenings thanks to Travelling Lanterns consisting of a glass dome and a metal handle. Designed to hold a classic or medium-sized candle, this graceful object single-handedly enchants the atmosphere with the warm, intimate sensations it creates. The collection is completed by the black porcelain Candle Lid topped with the inverted pyramid Diptyque logo. When one of our extra large candles is extinguished, this indispensable accessory is the perfect way to protect the wax and preserve the scent. Hand-crafted by Manufacture de Couleuvre with all their exceptional expertise in the art of porcelain-making, it adds the finishing touch to a summertime collection characterised by elegance and subtlety.

Delicate gifts to take wherever you go, even to the most far-flung corners of the globe. Special treasures to add enchantment to our everyday lives. This new collection of decorative objects holds out the promise of a truly memorable summer.
