Diptyque has always celebrated the dialogue between nature and craftsmanship in sophisticated decorative creations inspired by the spirit of the seasons and the elegance of the plant world. This year, the Maison unveils a collection that gives spring free rein to flourish: a delicate, poetic herbarium that offers a sensorial immersion in which shapes, materials and scents work together in perfect harmony.

THE HERBARIUM OF SCENTS – A SPRINGTIME AWAKENING

Spring is a season of rebirth – and it was in this spirit that Diptyque, drawing inspiration from its Herbarium of Scents, set out to express the reawakening of the natural world in decorative objects steeped in poetry. The exquisite penmanship of Julie Serre brings fresh life to the emblematic Baies (Berries), Roses and Mimosa fragrances. Her sophisticated plant illustrations are featured across a selection of limited edition objects.

At the heart of this collection, the Oval Trays in enamelled porcelain become objects as conducive to contemplation as they are to practical use. They also make a perfect combination with the illustrated Matchboxes, every detail of which tells an olfactory and visual story. We also welcome a new arrival to complement our Classic Candles: Lids made of hand-blown borosilicate glass – a first for the Maison, created in collaboration with Italian master glass-blower Massimo Lunardon, whose workshop is noted for preserving traditional skills at an exceptionally high level. The Lids are topped with decorative three-dimensional plant motifs, displaying a delicate, sophisticated aesthetic while prolonging the scent of a candle and protecting its wax. Along with the fragrances of the Mimosa, Muguet (Lily of the Valley), Baies (Berries), Roses and Violette (Violet) candles, these motifs augment the olfactory experience and elevate each lid.

Each element in this collection illustrates a vision of springtime, combining delicacy and radiance and transforming interior decoration into a veritable garden of the imagination replete with refined scents and textures to transport the senses.





AN EXCLUSIVE COLLECTION OF VASES FROM SAM BARON

The theme of floral inspiration is continued in an exclusive series of borosilicate glass vases signed by Sam Baron. In an interplay of contrasts and carefully judged proportions, each vase was designed to hold a particular type of bouquet, offering a subtle interaction between the container and the floral composition it holds.

The round Bouquet Vase echoes the Maison's iconic glass Torsade Candle Holder, and is the epitome of timeless, understated elegance.

Three other models available exclusively in the Maisons Diptyque in Paris and London demonstrate the Maison's commitment to working with gifted artists capable of drawing on a mix of traditional and innovative techniques to enhance glassware. The celebration of springtime is further enriched with the Stem, Bulb and Branch Vases, each designed to showcase a particular type of plant.

These creations are designed to transform any living space into a living tableau – the plant kingdom interacting with light and dimensions to capture the very essence of spring in all its glory.



For this collection, nature and craftsmanship come together in a meeting orchestrated by Diptyque, each creation encapsulating the spirit and poetry of springtime. Shapes, materials and fragrances are woven together to achieve a subtle balance, revealing a vision of spring that is vibrant, yet serene. The collection invites us to compose a living interior in which light, perfumes and objects combine to celebrate the rebirth of nature.
